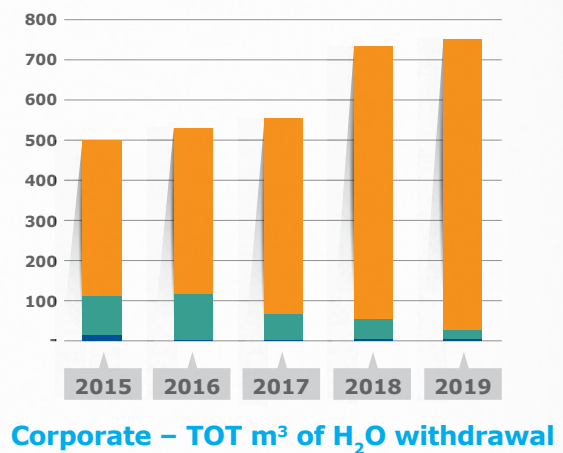
SUSTAINABLE FOCUS

FOCUS

For Riri, Sustainability and Transparency are two key concepts underlying our corporate values: this is why we have decided to share our Corporate achievements in respect of Sustainability performance levels.

The total emissions by the Group have remained almost unvaried, despite the business growth and increase in turnover compared to the previous year.

Based on surveys conducted over the past few years, we have selected and implemented some in-house improvement areas which have led to an overall **drop by 40%** of direct greenhouse gas emissions from sources owned or controlled by our company (Scope 1), as well as of indirect emissions associated with power production and use (Scope 2).

Other indirect emissions (Scope 3), on the other hand, have increased. This is due to the fact that this category reflects the indirect impacts associated with the supply chain and with specific market-driven product demand.

This scenario has provided valuable strategic input to focus on the improvement of Sustainability performances all along Riri's Supply Chain, within which it will be possible to intervene proactively, and in an even more effective way, through innovation and continuous collaboration between Suppliers and Customers.

RESPONSIBLE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT
